How long do I have to file a case against the government?

Often cases against the government require the satisfaction of two deadlines. Just like most other cases, any case against the government must be filed with a specified period of time otherwise the ability to recover may be forever lost. However, these cases often have a second deadline separate from the statute of limitations that requires the appropriate branch of the government be placed on notice within a specified period of time.
